

TEEN NIGHT POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Due to the fantastic growth of our Teen Night event, we are immediately implementing new policies and procedures that will help make this event even safer for your teen, as well as help us provide a better event.

1. Teen Night begins at 7:00 p.m. Parents/Guardians may drop teen's off beginning at 6:45 p.m. at the front entrance.
2. Staff will be located outside or at the front entrance checking to make sure Teen Night participants are on the pre-registration list as well as making sure they enter the building. Please do not pull away until all of the teens in your vehicle are verified.
3. Once teens are in the building, they cannot leave unless a parent/guardian is present to them pick up and sign them out.
4. All Teen Night participants who are members must have a completed waiver signed by a parent/guardian. (The waiver is good for the entire Teen Night season September-May).
5. All Teen Night participants who are not members must have a completed waiver signed by a parent/guardian before each teen night. (The Teen Night waivers are available on-line at www.buehlerymca.org.)
6. Hats are not allowed. Please leave your hats with the parent who drops you off. If you have a hat on while entering the building, it will be taken from you and held until the end of the evening.
7. Girls: Mini skirts, midriffs and see through outfits are not permitted. If you are wearing a piece of inappropriate clothing, you will not be admitted into the event.
8. If you are wearing a piece of clothing that has inappropriate gestures or foul or suggestive language, you will be asked to take it off and provided a shirt to wear for the evening or be asked to turn the piece of clothing inside out so that the item in question is not visible. If any further action is required, parents/guardians will be immediately contacted.
9. Teens are expected to be respectful of the staff/volunteers, one another, and facility. Anyone caught being disrespectful may be asked to leave Teen Night, at which time a parent/guardian will be contacted to pick the teen up or even banned from participating in future Teen Nights.
10. There is absolutely no tolerance for fighting. If a fight should occur, both parties involved will be immediately banned from participating in the remainder of the evening and both parties parents/guardian's will be called to pick the teens involved up. It will be at the discretion of person in charge whether the parties will be banned from participating in future Teen Nights.
11. On the dance floor, teens are expected to refrain from bumping, grinding, dirty dancing or any other type of lewd, suggestive dance moves. Teens will be given one warning and then lose the privilege of participating in the dance portion of the evening. If any further action is required, parents/guardians will be immediately contacted.
12. The YMCA is a drug-free/smoke-free environment.
13. We believe in the core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility.
14. Teens must be picked up at 10:00 p.m. Parents/Guardians must come into the building to sign them out. NO teens are allowed to leave the building without a parent/guardian. If a child is not picked up by 10:15 p.m. without a prior phone call or explanation, your child could lose his or her privileges to attend the next

- month's Teen Night. If they are not picked up by 10:30 p.m., the police will be contacted.
15. **Just as we expect the teens to be respectful, your respect, cooperation and promptness is appreciated.**
 16. If for any reason someone is banned from participating in a Teen Night for the evening or for future Teen Nights, the parents/guardians will be contacted.
 17. Teen night registration fees are nonrefundable and non-transferable. If a teen is banned from participating in one or more Teen Night events, any registration fees paid are non-refundable.
