MINI CAMP | AGES 7-16

SESSION 3 (6/28 - 7/1) & SESSION 7 (8/2 - 8/5)

Mini Camp gives campers a taste of our classic overnight camp experience in just a few days. Enjoy outdoor adventures, cabin games, creative activities, and cozy campfire nights — all packed into a whirlwind of friendship, laughter, and summer memories. This mini session is perfect for first-time campers or anyone who is looking for a quick, exciting getaway!

During session 7, campers will have the opportunity to extend their stay for the full week with approval from their guardian.

1-WEEK SESSIONS | AGES 7-15

SESSION 1 (6/14 - 6/19): GIRLS IN THE WILDERNESS

This one-week session is designed for girls who want to explore, create, and have fun together! Campers will enjoy a mix of outdoor adventures, creative arts, team challenges, and special activities that inspire confidence, friendship, and leadership.

SESSION 2 (6/21 - 6/26): TRADITIONAL OVERNIGHT CAMP

Campers will explore the outdoors, try exciting activities like swimming, archery, and climbing, and enjoy classic camp traditions like campfires and songs. With cabins full of new friends, games that spark teamwork, and plenty of laughter, this week offers our traditional overnight camp experience.

SESSION 5 (7/12 - 7/17): WIZARDS & WONDERS

Step into a world of magic this summer! Together, we'll craft wands, uncover hidden mysteries, and test our courage in magical adventures. Whether they're solving riddles, mixing mysterious brews, or competing in wizard tournaments, campers are sure to leave this week spellbound!

2-WEEK SESSIONS | AGES 7-16

SESSION 4 (7/5 - 7/17): TRADITIONAL OVERNIGHT CAMP

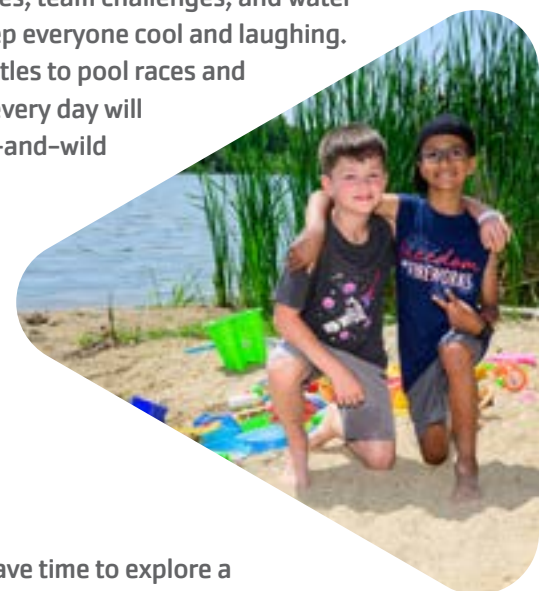

Make a big splash before summer ends! Campers will dive into water games, team challenges, and water adventures that keep everyone cool and laughing. From epic water battles to pool races and slippery-slide fun, every day will be packed with wet-and-wild excitement.



SPECIALTY CAMP OPTIONS

SESSION 2 (6/21 – 6/26): LEADERS IN TRAINING | AGES 15-16

Leaders in Training is designed for teens who want to develop the skills that they'll need to grow into effective leaders. During the one-week program, teens work on team building, leadership, problem-solving, and camp skills through group work experiences and adventure activities. Participants also take part in traditional camp activities!

SESSION 4 (7/5 – 7/17): COUNSELORS IN TRAINING | AGES 16-17

Counselors in Training is designed for teens who are ready for future leadership roles as summer camp counselors. Campers will spend their first week learning leadership skills and participating in traditional camp activities. They will then spend their second week living in a cabin with younger campers and getting a feel for everything that being a counselor entails.

SESSION 4* (7/5 – 7/10): FIRST TIMERS CAMP | AGES 7-12

Ready to try Overnight Camp for the first time? This camp removes the pressure of being an expert camper. Youth enjoy a week of learning and growing together and begin to experience the magic of camp as they engage in activities in a physically and emotionally safe atmosphere! This camp is designed to meet the unique social, emotional, and intellectual needs of a younger, first-time camper.

REGISTRATION

A non-refundable admin fee/deposit of \$150 per week per camper is due at the time of registration. The deposit will go toward the total payment of the camp week. Balance of camp fees are due four weeks ahead of the check-in day for your child's camp session. Fees are non-refundable after payment due date. If your camper becomes ill a doctor's note is required to accompany the request for refund. We will first try to move your camper's registration to another open week. All forms must be submitted before your camper's first day of camp.

OUR FAMILY GUIDE

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

We believe every child should have the opportunity to experience camp regardless of their financial situation. Camp Duncan works with several resources to help meet the needs of as many families who want to attend summer camp as possible.

2026 applications are available beginning the first week of January 2026 and can be initiated by calling the camp office at 847-546-8086 or emailing campduncan@ymcachicago.org. Once monies are allocated families will be notified. A deposit is required to hold your child's spot even if you are awarded a full or partial scholarship. If you do not qualify you will be notified. Funds are limited and are available on a first come first serve basis.

FOOD SERVICE

Nutritious meals are an important part of camp. Our dedicated kitchen staff provide three kid-friendly, family-style meals a day plus an evening snack. All meals are included in the registration fee. Our food service department can also make reasonable accommodations for food allergies and special dietary needs as long as they are requested ahead of time in registration documentation.

TRANSPORTATION

Camp Duncan is conveniently located one hour north of Chicago, one hour south of Milwaukee, and 30 minutes west of Gurnee — making it easy for parents to drop off and pick up their child at camp.

If you are unable to drive to Camp Duncan, we now offer a pick-up option! Our staff will pick up and drop off campers at the Fox Lake station on the Metra Milwaukee District North (MD-N) line. The Fox Lake station is a 10-minute drive from Camp Duncan. Families (including parents!) can take the train together on drop-off and pick-up days.
