<b>5:00PM-8:30PM</b>	<b>Arrival—Camp Store</b> Please check in with staff at the Camp Store. We are very excited to assist you & make sure your arrival goes smoothly. Please let staff know if you have any questions or if there is anything we can help you with. Your cabin has been cleaned but we encourage all campers to wash their dishes prior to cooking.
<b>5:00PM-8:30PM</b>	<b>Activity Sign Ups- Camp Store</b> Boat-in-Breakfast, Archery, Tie Dying, & the Wildlife session requires you to sign up because they are so popular! Check availability in the Camp Store all week!
<b>DAILY 9:30AM-5:30PM</b>	Please be considerate of other families who want to participate in the activities, so avoid signing up for an activity twice until Nawakwa staff says it's OK- this is especially important during our busy weeks! Swim Evaluations are available upon request between 5-8pm tonight! Then any time a lifeguard is on duty & it's not too busy with swimmers.
<b>5:00PM-8:30PM</b>	<b>Rental Boat Pick Up- Camp Store</b> Did you reserve a pontoon, motorboat, or the fishing boat? Stop by the Camp Store to pick up the key & for an orientation on how to operate the boat! If you did not reserve a boat prior to your arrival & are interested in reserving, ask Nawakwa staff because we may have some available! All available rental boats are first come, first serve, so stop by if you are interested!

<b>10:00AM</b>	<b>Learn to Play Gaga Ball- Gaga Ball Pit (North Camp Playground)</b> Don't know the rules to Gaga Ball? Come & learn! The counselors are excited to teach you the Nawakwa rules & see who has been practicing. All ages are welcome to play! A gaga ball should always be found inside the pit but check with the Camp Store if you can't find it!
<b>10:00AM-11:00AM</b>	<b>Sailing Orientation—North Camp Beach</b> <u>You will get in the water! In order to use the sailboats, you must attend this orientation &amp; pass an evaluation. You must be 13 &amp; older to sail alone. If you sailed with us last year, you have a condensed orientation!</u> After completion of the orientation, your name will go on a list & you can check out the dagger boards in the Camp Store. You will only be able to check out a sailboat for 2 hours at a time. This helps make sure everyone who wants to sail gets a chance to sail!
<b>11:00AM-12:00PM</b>	<b>Swim Evaluations—North Camp Beach</b> All children 12 & under will need to participate in a swim evaluation. The swim evaluation determines the areas your child can swim in without a lifejacket. Upon completing the swim evaluation, the Nawakwa staff will give your child a bracelet. This bracelet needs to be worn while participating in all swimming & boating activities, so lifeguards know who has been evaluated or not.
<b>11:30AM</b>	<b>Camper Orientation &amp; Waterfront Safety —North Camp Beach</b> We encourage campers to attend camper orientation. Hear emergency procedures, garbage protocols, laundry, waterfront, & equipment use. Come with any questions you may have! <u>Children under the age of 12 are not allowed to use canoes, kayaks, paddleboards, or rowboats without someone 18+ joining them. All campers must wear life jackets when on watercrafts- this is Wisconsin law!</u>
